

# FUNDING ALIGNMENT

## IDEA, Part B: Individuals with Disabilities Education Act

The IDEA governs how states and public agencies provide early intervention, special education, and related services to children with disabilities. It addresses the educational needs of children with disabilities from birth to age 21. Districts and schools are permitted to use up to 15% of their IDEA funds for interventions and measurements to be used with Response to Intervention (RTI) services. The charts below display how Wireless Generation solutions align to guidelines set forth in IDEA, Part B.

<p>Develop and implement coordinated, early intervening education services for students in all grades, with a particular emphasis on students in Grades K-3, who have not been identified as needing special education or related services but need additional academic support to succeed in general education</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▶ At its core, mCLASS:RTI is designed to deliver a sustained intervention program to the students who are struggling the most in a manner that meets their learning needs and enables decision making to improve upon student outcomes.</li></ul>
